The scholarship offers financial support and will be given to a graduating senior with plans to pursue a college degree. The scholarship offers the 1st place winner an initial stipend of \$5,000.00 and continuously provides additional assistance in the amount of \$1,000.00 for three consecutive years thereafter, yielding a total of \$8,000.00 over a period of four (4) years. In addition to the 1st place scholarship award, several non-renewable scholarships will be given by the organization in amounts to be determined. The scholarship committee will meet to select the scholarship recipients during the month of March 2023. The winners will be notified upon completion of the process. All scholarships will be based upon the following criteria: Academic Achievement, Character, Essay, Recommendations and an in-person interview.

The scholarship applicant must:

- ___ 1 Be a U.S. Citizen
- ___ 2 Have a minimum grade point average of 2.5 or higher
- ___ 3 Be an African-American male
- ___ 4 Submit a completed application and two letters of recommendation from any of the following:
 - a. High School teacher AND/OR counselor
 - b. Community Leader (Community Activist, Business Owner, Minister, etc.)
- ___ 5 Have an official (certified) high school transcript sent to the scholarship committee chairperson
- ___ 6 Submit a typed, one-to-two paged essay (to include) a description of honors (*i.e. National Honors List, Dean's List, etc.*), educational achievements, community service, and the role this scholarship will play in his financial need.
- ___ 7 Attend a personal interview, scheduled by the Pi Nu Chapter Scholarship Committee (Applicants will be notified by the Committee)
